

Family Physician Positions

The Department of Family Medicine is seeking two family physicians to join the Queen's Family Health Organization (FHO) in beautiful, historic <u>Kingston, Ontario (visitkingston.ca</u>). Clinical responsibilities will be based within the Queen's Family Health Team (QFHT).

Preferred candidates will assume existing practices and will roster new patients. They will be members of the on-call group providing call approximately one night per month and three weekends per year. One of the positions will also involve provision of family medicine obstetrics, including intrapartum care at Kingston Health Sciences Centre and participation in the Family Medicine Obstetrics on-call group.

Preferred candidates will have demonstrated experience or interest in clinical teaching of both undergraduate medical students and postgraduate trainees. With the implementation of competency-based medical education (CBME) and assessment into the department's postgraduate program, successful candidates will be required to participate on a regular basis in the supervision of residents and medical students. This will include serving as an academic advisor for assigned residents, completing field notes and in-training evaluations; participating in practice examinations and in the preparation of such examinations; and attending faculty development sessions, in addition to continuing medical education as per departmental expectations.

Applicants must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario on or before the appointment start date, and preference will be given to applicants who have current, valid certification (or equivalent) in family medicine from the College of Family Physicians of Canada.

We are committed to employment equity and diversity in the workplace and welcome applications from individuals from equity-seeking groups such as women, racialized/visible minorities, Indigenous/Aboriginal peoples, persons with a disability, persons who identify in the LGBTQ2S+ community, and others who reflect the diversity of Canadian society.

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, in accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada will be given priority. We will provide support in the application process to applicants with disabilities, including accommodation that takes into account an applicant's accessibility and accommodation needs during the interview process.
