	Supervisor willing to review resident objectives prior to arrival	
	Clear understanding of resident scope of practice	
	Staff member prepared to complete written evaluation of resident	
Safety	Appropriate accommodation and transportation arranged	
	Organization or supervisor prepared to help resident return to Canada should emergency arise	
	If remote (ie: no internet access), organization or supervisor able to demonstrate effective method of communication between resident and department while overseas	
	Organization adheres to international legislation with respect to border crossings, customs, visas, and all other matters of international or national law
